IF STRONG/LEAN ENDORSED CANDIDATE

That's great to hear, thank you for your support! I want to make sure you're aware about your voting options for the runoff election. You have to cast another ballot for both Warnock and Ossoff in the January 5th run-off election. Just like in the November election, you will be able to vote early in-person or vote by mail. For the runoff election, how do you plan to vote-- by mail, early in-person, or on Election Day, January 5th?

However, since no one reached over 50% of the vote, Georgia will now hold a January 5th run-off election between the top two from the November election - Reverend Warnock will be facing Republican Kelly Loeffler, and Jon Ossoff will be facing Republican David Perdue.

That means we need to get out the vote one more time and vote for Reverend Warnock and Jon Ossoff in the runoff! Can we count on you to vote one more time?
